**Tuition:** Masterclasses will be led by members of the Vogler Quartet and other festival performers. Ensemble activities will be directed by Prof James Cavanagh, curator. **Adult Tutors:** We hope that one tutor will attend with each group of young musicians. Tutors are expected to participate fully in the programme and to take sectionals on Saturday / Sunday. Tutor fees will be paid via your local Music Generation office. Please contact your local office for details.

**Supervision:** One or two chaperones are required to attend with each group of young musicians and be the contact person for the weekend. Chaperones will be expected to manage students' welfare for the weekend.

**Accommodation:** Organised by Music Generation Sligo on behalf of the group, in a hotel or guest house in twin/ triple/ quadruple rooms. Chaperones will stay in the same accommodation and are responsible for supervision.
